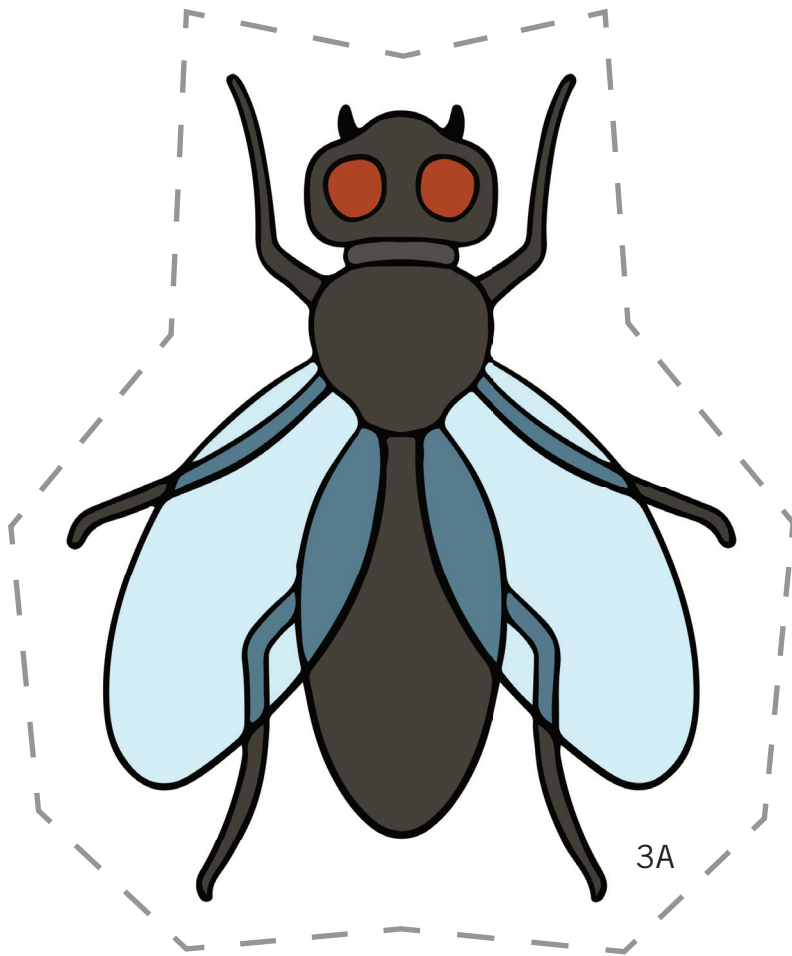

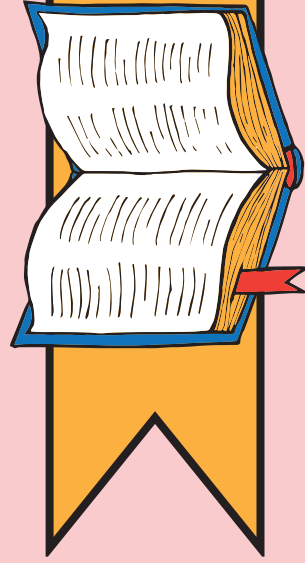


Heart Doors
