
Jesus Puzzle Assembly Directions

- Cut a piece of foam board down to 18 inches wide by 22 1/2 inches tall (There will be a 1 inch border around the finished puzzle.)
- Trim the margins off of the four Jesus Puzzle Grid pages. Glue the grid pages to the foam board following the placement shown on the diagram below.
- Cut out the puzzle pieces from the four Jesus Puzzle Piece pages.
- To make the Jesus puzzle more durable and to help if last for many years, laminate both the puzzle grid and the puzzle pieces. Then attach small velcro pieces to the back of each puzzle piece and the coordinating location on the puzzle grid. This is a durable and simple way for students to attach the pieces to the puzzle during the lesson.
- The Jesus Puzzle Picture provides a reference for teachers to see what the completed puzzle looks like.
